Experience in one or more of following areas is preferred, but not required:

- Previous teaching experience

Remuneration:

1. \$50/hour + superannuation for teaching. You may also have a number of private students, at the request of our private students – you may organise these private teaching hours around your own timetable.

2. \$30/hour + superannuation for all other tasks, which will primarily include course and content development. The hours for development are flexible – you are able to organise the hours around your current schedule.

Expected Time Commitment:

- **Over the Summer and During the semester:** ~5-10 (or more if desired) hours per week for Content Development work, dependent on your interest.
- **April:** must be available one or two days for most weekends; expect to work 3 to 7 hours per day.
- Teaching date for rest of year TBD

Content development work is done remotely (WFH) and your schedule is flexible - as long as the agreed work is complete on time

Teaching hours during the weekends stated above will largely be in person and schedule preset for you. However, any private tutoring work you do with students will be flexible according to your schedule and can be done remotely if preferred by both you and your student.
